



## •12 Tucumcari Lake and Wildlife

Area The 770-acre reserve provides excellent wildlife viewing. It has a shallow lake and the wetlands attract numerous birds.

Quay County has majestic sandstone vistas, mesas and mountains, the wild Canadian River, and plains that are the home to a variety of wildlife. Visitors can see pronghorn antelope, mule deer, geese, cranes, quail and many others.
