In the northeast corner of New Mexico lies Union County. The county contains many natural assets including Capulin Volcano, vast grasslands, lakes, and rivers.

- **1 Clayton Lake State Park and Dinosaur Trackway** features a 170-acre reservoir and a fossil trackway of dinosaur footprints. Located 15 miles north of Clayton.

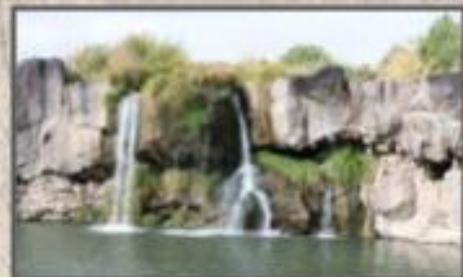
- **2 Capulin Volcano National Monument** Views are spectacular day or night from the volcanic rim and it has one of the darkest night skies in the country.

- **3 Folsom Museum** The collection includes artifacts of historical and cultural value from the time of prehistoric Folsom Man through the period of westward expansion

- **4 Rabbit Ears Mountain** was a guiding landmark for Santa Fe Trail travelers on the Cimarron Route. It can be viewed from Kiowa National Grassland and the Santa Fe Trail National Scenic Byway west of Clayton.

- **5 Folsom Falls** about 3 miles northeast of the town of Folsom, New Mexico, along New Mexico State Highway 456.



- **6 Herzstein Memorial Museum** devoted to the care, interpretation, and exhibit of artifacts and documents associated with Union County and northeastern NM.

- **7 Amistad Gymnasium Museum** Est. in 1937, it stands as an example of the many rural gymnasium / auditorium projects New Deal programs carried out in New Mexico.

- **8 Eklund Hotel** has been a landmark for travelers of the southwest since the 1890s where an elaborately carved bar is still in use in the saloon.

- **9 The Luna Theater** a historic theatre built in 1916. Recently restored and updated to digital projection and surround sound. A must-see venue for movies and entertainment.

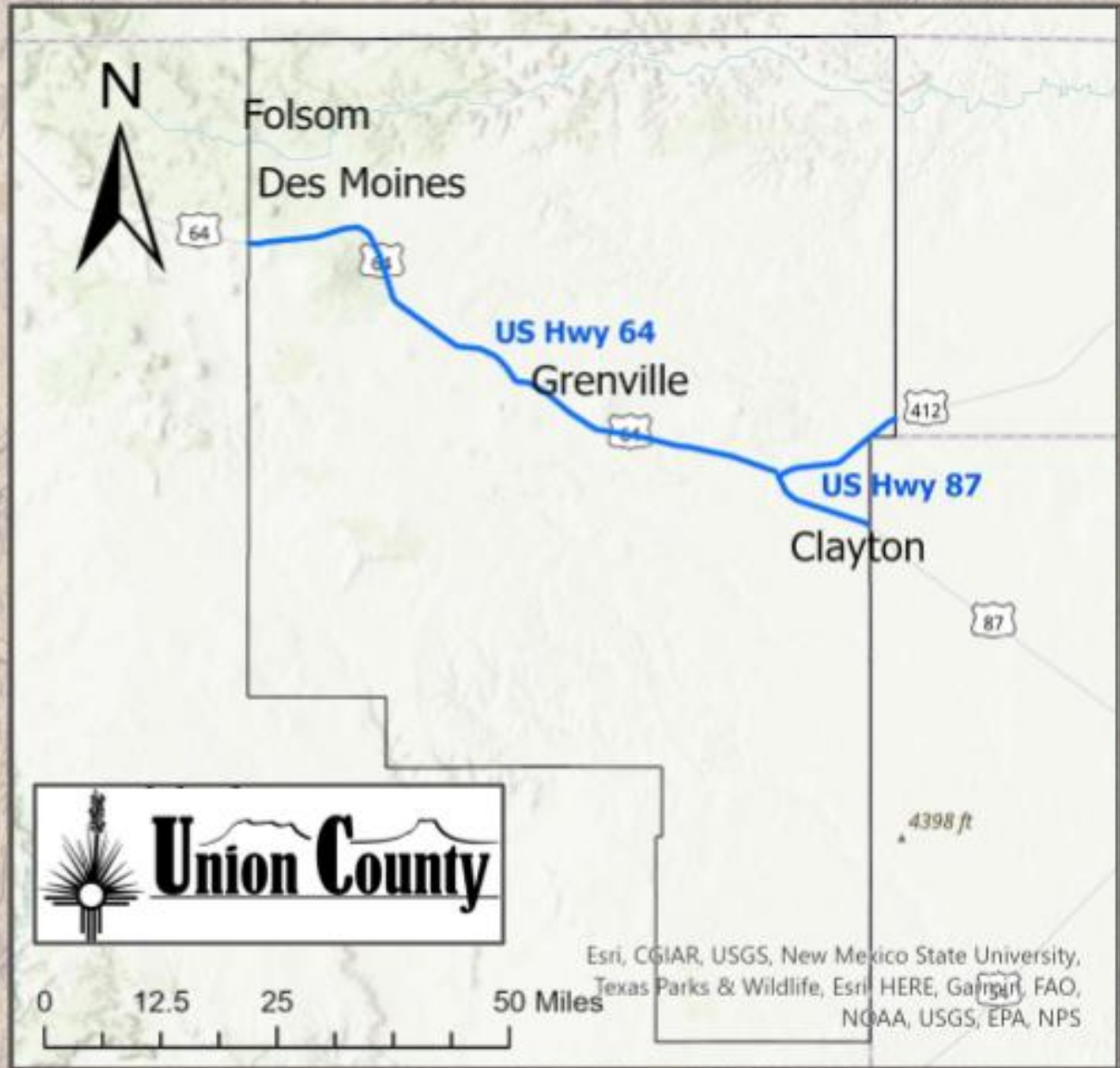
